Amrita Ramanan is a dramaturg, creative producer, and artistic leader who holds the values of antiracism, anti-colonialism, equity, access, and inclusion at the core of her practice. She is the Senior Cultural Strategist and Dramaturg for Play On Shakespeare, an organization dedicated to creating contemporary modern-verse translations of Shakespeare's plays.
